#### **AUDIENCE EXPERIENCE**

The viewer is invited into a space where light and sound intertwine to create a contemplative, sensory experience. **SOUL OF RADIANCE** is a piece to observe and to feel—a quiet pause where beauty emerges as a pure state of presence.

### **A LIVING ORGANISM**

Here, light behaves like a sensitive organism that breathes with the sound. Its forms shift in response to frequencies, generating ever-changing visual textures and adapting to the geometry of the space.



The piece becomes a body in transition, constantly evolving, a reminder that everything in the universe is in perpetual motion. Within this shifting landscape, SOUL OF RADIANCE opens an inner space where the ephemeral becomes tangible and the invisible takes shape.

### **MULTIPLE FORMATS**

**SOUL OF RADIANCE** can be adapted to both indoor settings—such as theaters or galleries—and outdoor environments, provided that technical and environmental conditions are suitable. It can be presented in different projection formats: on a water vapor curtain, tulle or gobelin fabric, or directly on an LED screen, depending on the spatial and technical requirements.
